No one could have walked or driven up Broadway this fall without doing a double take. Cartoonish bronze sculptures such as *Miser*, a man clutching pennies and balancing on a globe, *Escaping Leg*, a skinny 21-foot tall appendage, and the despondent *Crying Giant* (left) dotted the Broadway Mall from 60th to 168th Streets. The 25-statue installation, created by New York artist Tom Otterness, runs through March 18. New Yorkers may recognize Otterness's playful work from permanent installations in the Governor Nelson A.
